## **Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony Officially Celebrates Ambrell's All-New Rochester, NY Manufacturing Plant**

### ***Six Month project successfully concludes with opening new 80,000 square foot facility***

The \$2.1 million project, which started in September 2017, included a complete company relocation from its previous manufacturing facility in Scottsville, NY.
